MIRCI UPHOLDING MENTAL HEALTH

After years of planning and development, Mirci has a big announcement: **The transitional home for female-identifying youth has been greenlit!** We've worked with the SC Housing Trust Fund for months, and at their meeting on January 17, funding was approved by the SC Housing Authority Board of Commissioners.

This home will serve young adults 17 to under 22 who are facing housing instability and homelessness. At this crucial developmental age, the negative consequences of housing instability put youth at much higher risk of long-term homelessness, traumatic experiences, and poorer physical and mental health.

With transitional housing, these young adults will have access to stable housing and mentorship. They will have access to Mirci's wraparound services, which include behavioral healthcare and transportation assistance. Staff with trauma-informed training will be available on-site 24/7. Residents will create goals, like pursuing education or improving relationships with caregivers or other supportive adults.

We're excited to share updates and show tangible progress on the project in the coming months!
